Have you been to watch a lesson?



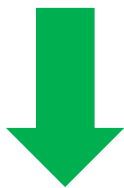
If you'd like to become a regular volunteer at the RDA lessons, speak to an instructor or committee member to get an application form.

Have you filled in your application form?



Make sure it is completed fully, **including the references**. Bring it with you when you first come to volunteer as you cannot take part in the lessons until it has been completed and checked by a committee member or an instructor.

Are you under 14 years old?



You will need a parent or guardian to sign a disclaimer before you can begin volunteering.

Have you been Green Carded by an Instructor?



The instructor will explain to you how to lead the horses or side walk next to a rider, according to RDA standards.

Are you over 16 years old?

You will need to have a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check. If you have had a current DBS check within the last 6 months **OR** if you have subscribed to the DBS updating service and give RDA permission to access it - we may be able to use this instead of completing a new disclosure.
